The survey is 15 questions and should take approximately 5-10 minutes to complete. All of the responses collected from this survey will be recorded anonymously.

The data collected from this survey will be presented to various stakeholders in North Dakota in regards to competitive pay employment opportunities for individuals with intellectual and/ or developmental disabilities.
